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**Subject:** Relaxation under Rule 161(iv) of General Financial Rules 2017 for issuance of Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) for procurement of Medical Devices-reg

Reference captioned subject, please find enclosed latest OM F.41/1/2023-PPD(pt.)dt 28.06.2024 (copy enclosed) issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India for kind perusal and adherence.

DoE vide above circular has granted general exemption under Rule 161 (iv) of GFRs 2017, from the instructions issued vide OMs No. F.1211712019-PPD dated 15.05.2020 & 28.05.2020, for issuance of GTE for procurement of **354 Medical Devices** enclosed at Annexure-A **till 31.03.2027 or further orders.**

It is further informed that procurement is a dynamic process and there may be instances where local manufacturers may become available for certain equipment/items in the exempted list. Accordingly, procuring entities are advised to ensure due diligence to Make in India guidelines in all cases of procurement of equipment without relying solely on the enclosed list.

Additionally, it is reiterated that it is the sole responsibility of the Head of the Institution to ensure that procurement done by respective user units should strictly adhere to ESIC Equipment norms, Delegation of Powers, ESIC Medical Equipment manual and mandatory adherence of all statutory procurement guidelines (GeM, MII, GFR, CVC) while ensuring generic specifications, budgetary provisions, availability of infrastructure, manpower, approval for starting the services issued from ESIC Hqrs along with local financial concurrence such that in no case an equipment remains unutilized after procurement.

This issues with the approval of Medical Commissioner.
